

UMJETNIČKA ŠKOLA
MIROSLAV MAGDALENIĆ
ČAKOVEC

Glazbeno obrazovanje u Čakovcu svoj početak bilježi 8. siječnja 1946. kada je odobreno osnivanje prve Muzičke škole u Čakovcu koja je u to vrijeme djelovala u vrlo skromnim uvjetima – između ostalog i u prostorijama nekadašnje konjušnice, te sa svega nekoliko učitelja i dvadesetak učenika.

Od 30. lipnja 1954. škola postaje Muzički tečaj Čakovec, 13. ožujka 1964. tečaj postaje Područno odjeljenje Muzičke škole u Varaždinu, a 13. srpnja 1972. odjel se izdvaja i postaje Osnovna muzička škola Čakovec pri Radničkom sveučilištu Čakovec. Odlukom Skupštine Međimurske županije 27. rujna 1995. izdvajanjem iz Radničkog sveučilišta škola postaje Osnovna umjetnička škola Čakovec i seli na sadašnju lokaciju u ul. V. Nazora 14 u Čakovcu, 2003. godine počinje s radom i Baletni odjel, a 23. listopada 2006. mijenja naziv u Umjetničku školu Miroslav Magdalenić Čakovec.

U sastavu škole je Osnovna glazbena škola, Osnovna baletna škola, Glazbena igraonica i Glazbeni tečaj, a djeluje na pet lokacija: Čakovec – Glazbeni odjel i Baletni odjel, Mursko Središće, Prelog i Donji Kraljevec, a nastava se odvija na 10 solističkih instrumenata, 2 teorijska predmeta i skupog muziciranja (Puhački orkestar, ansambl harmonika, gitara, limenih puhača, drvenih puhača, 3 komorna zbora i veliki dječji zbor).

Škola u suradnji s Hrvatskim društvom gudačkih pedagoga i pod pokroviteljstvom Grada Čakovca bienalno organizira eminentno Međunarodno gudačko natjecanje Rudolf Matz, održavaju se produkcije klasa, odjela, koncerti škole uz veliku podršku osnivača – Grada Čakovca. Učenici i djelatnici škole aktivno sudjeluju u kulturnom, glazbenom i javnom životu grada i županije. Učenici škole redovito sudjeluju na regionalnim, državnim i međunarodnim natjecanjima gdje osvajaju izuzetno vrijedne i visoke nagrade, a glazbeni pedagozi vrijedno rade na svom stručnom usavršavanju kako bi savjesno i odgovorno njegovali talente i vještine mlađih glazbenika, a time i postizali zavidne rezultate. Iz okrilja škole izašao je velik broj glazbenih i plesnih pedagoga, izvođača, solista, članova ansambala i orkestara, koji svoje umjetničke početke zahvaljuju upravo ovoj Školi. Nastavljajući svoje srednjoškolsko i visokoškolsko obrazovanje, stječući zvanja i visoke titule, odgajajući nove naraštaje glazbenika u našoj i drugim školama; bivši učenici svjedoče o kontinuitetu glazbenog i plesnog obrazovanja, kvaliteti rada i predanosti glazbenih i plesnih pedagoga – članova kolektiva naše škole.



Music education in Čakovec began on January 8, 1946 when the establishment of the first Music School in Čakovec was approved. The school operated at that time in very modest conditions – among other things in the premises of the former horse-stable, with only a few teachers and twenty students.

On June 30, 1954 the school became the Music Course Čakovec and on March 13, 1964 the course became the Regional Department of Music School in Varaždin, but on July 13, 1972 the department separated from the school in Varaždin and became the Primary Music School Čakovec at the Workers' University of Čakovec. The school then separated from the Workers' University and became the Primary Art School Čakovec with the decision of the County Assembly of Medimurje on September 27, 1995. It moved to its present location Vladimira Nazora 14 in Čakovec and in 2003 the Ballet Department started its activities. On October 23, 2006 the name of the school was changed to the Art School Miroslav Magdalenić Čakovec.

The school consists of the Primary Music School, Primary Ballet School, Music Playroom and Music Course, and it operates in 5 locations: Čakovec – Music Department and Ballet Department, Mursko Središće, Prelog and Donji Kraljevec. The teaching involves 10 solo instruments, 2 theoretical subjects and collective playing (Wind Orchestra, accordion, guitar, brass and woodwind ensembles, 3 chamber choirs and a large children's choir).

In cooperation with the Croatian Society of String Pedagogues and under the auspices of the City of Čakovec, the School biennially organizes the renowned International Rudolf Matz Competition. Public performances, departmental and school concerts are also held with the great support of the founder – the City of Čakovec, and the students and school staff actively participate in cultural, musical and public life of the city and the county. The students regularly participate in regional, state and international competitions, where they win extremely valuable and high prizes, and music teachers are well-versed in their professional training and they conscientiously nurture the talents and skills of young musicians and thus achieve ambitious results. Numerous music and dance pedagogues, performers, soloists, members of the ensemble and orchestra have been students here, and they thank this school for their artistic beginnings. By continuing their secondary and tertiary education, by gaining vocations and high titles, educating new generations of musicians in our and other schools, our former students are witnessing the continuity of music and dance education, the quality of work and commitment of music and dance pedagogues – members of our school staff.



ANDELKO KRPAN

violina (Zagreb, Hrvatska) – Predsjednik
violin (Zagreb, Croatia) – President

Andelko Krpan (Zagreb, 1967.) je profesor violine i prodekan za umjetnost Muzičke akademije u Zagrebu. Diplomirao je violinu na *Muzičkoj akademiji* u Zagrebu, u klasi Kristijana Petrovića 1989., te magistrirao na *Hochschule für Musik und darstellende Kunst* u Beču u klasi Dore Schwarzberg 1995. godine. Bio je član *Bečke komorne filharmonije* (1993.-97.), član *Zagrebačkih solista* (1993.-97.), koncertni majstor *Zagrebačkih solista* (1997.-2002.) i koncertni majstor *Orkestra HNK iz Zagreba* (2002.-2006.). Jedan je od utemeljitelja i prvi violinist Gudačkoga kvarteta Sebastian. Redovito svira i snima solistički i u različitim komornim sastavima. Do sada je snimio 20 CD-a za izdavačke kuće Croatia Records, Cantus, cpo...

Andelko Krpan (Zagreb, 1967.) is Violin professor and vice Dean for Art of Academy of Music in Zagreb. He graduated in Violin at the Academy of Music in Zagreb in the class of Kristijan Petrović (1989) and went on to earn his masters at the Hochschule für Musik und Darstellende Kunst in Vienna in the class of Dora Schwarzberg (1995). He has been a member of the Vienna Chamber Philharmonic (1989-93), then member of the Zagreb Soloists (1993-97), orchestra leader of the Zagreb Soloists (1997-2002) and concertmaster of Croatian National Theatre Orchestra of Zagreb (2002-2006). He is one of the founders and the first violinist of the Sebastian String Quartet. He recorded 20 CDs for Croatia Records, Cantus, cpo... recorded in collaboration with the pianist, Nada Majnarić.



JANEZ PODLESEK
violina (Ljubljana, Slovenija)

Janez Podlesek poznati je slovenski violinist i pedagog. Diplomirao je na Akademiji za glasbo u Ljubljani u klasi renomiranog profesora Primoža Novšaka, gdje je završio i poslijediplomski studij. Bio je koncertni majstor Slovenske filharmonije i Komornog gudačkog orkestra Slovenske filharmonije. Kao izvanredni profesor redovito je zaposlen na Akademiji za glasbo u Ljubljani. Tijekom studija osvojio je više nagrada na državnim i međunarodnim natjecanjima. Iza sebe ima brojne recitale i komorne koncerte. Aktivan je u raznim glazbenim sastavima. Na Konzervatoriju za glazbu i balet u Ljubljani i Akademiji za glasbo u Ljubljani predaje violinu i komornu glazbu te dirigira Komornim gudačkim orkestrom ULAG-a. Sudjeluje u ambicioznom projektu EMARS.

Janez Podlesek is a famous Slovenian violinist and pedagogue. He graduated from the Academy of Music in Ljubljana in the class of renowned professor Primož Novšak, where he also completed his postgraduate studies. He was the concertmaster of the Slovenian Philharmonic and the Chamber String Orchestra of the Slovenian Philharmonic. As an associate professor, he is regularly employed at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana. During his studies, he won several awards at national and international competitions. He has numerous recitals and chamber concerts behind him. He is active in various musical ensembles. He teaches violin and chamber music at the Conservatory of Music and Ballet in Ljubljana and the Academy of Music in Ljubljana and conducts the ULAG Chamber String Orchestra. He participates in the ambitious EMARS project.



KREŠIMIR PETAR PUSTIČKI
viola (Zagreb, Hrvatska)
viola (Zagreb, Croatia)

Krešimir Petar Pustički rođen je 1975. godine u Zagrebu. Zarana je iskazao apsolutan sluh i izrazitu glazbenu nadarenost. Tijekom školovanja osvaja državne nagrade na najvišem nivou (prva mjesta na natjecanjima u Zagrebu, Dubrovniku, Sarajevu i Beogradu, pobjednik Tribine *Darko Lukić*), a kao dva desetogodišnjaka diplomira je violu na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu, u klasi profesora Ante Živkovića. Na istoj je ustanovi 2009. godine stekao titulu magistra umjetnosti. Svoj veliki talent i svestranost u glazbi dokazuje i u Simfonijskom puhačkom orkestru HV-a, gdje je godinu dana bio angažiran kao pijanist Big Benda pod vodstvom Miljenka Prohaske. Krešimir Petar Pustički uspješan je komorni glazbenik te često nastupa s gudačkim triom *Pustički*. Nakon završenog studija, godinu dana radi kao stalni član Simfonijskog orkestra HRT-a, a od 1998. do 2008. godine stalni je član i vođa dionice viola Zagrebačkih solista. Od 2011. do 2018. stalni je honorarni vođa dionice viola u Simfonijskom orkestru HRT-a. Krešimir Petar Pustički trenutno je zaposlen na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu u svojstvu redovnog profesora. Uz pedagoški rad ima izrazito uspješnu solističku karijeru te ga kritika svrstava među najbolje hrvatske gudače. Aktivno se bavi i snimatelskim i producentskim radom, pri čemu je postao jedan od najtraženijih hrvatskih producenata te višestruko osvaja diskografske nagrade za najbolje alburne klasične glazbe.

Krešimir Petar Pustički was born in Zagreb in 1975. As an exceptionally talented child, from early on he discovered he had a perfect pitch. During his schooling he won the highest prizes at musical competitions (first prize in Zagreb, Dubrovnik, Sarajevo and Belgrade, as well as the Darko Lukić competition). He studied with prof. Ante Živković and as a 20-year-old graduated from the Academy of Music in Zagreb. In 2009 he obtained his Master of Arts degree. As a successful chamber musician he often plays with his siblings in a string trio PST. From 1998 till 2008 he was a member and a principal viola player in renowned Croatian chamber orchestra, the Zagreb Soloists, where critics often singled him out. In 2011 he started playing as a part-time principal violist in Croatian Radiotelevision Symphony Orchestra. Krešimir Petar Pustički works as an associate professor on the Academy of Music in Zagreb. He is distinguished soloist which Croatian critics find as one of the best Croatian string players. Pustički also proved himself to be a very successful recording producer, when he won Porin in 2007, 2022, 2024, Croatian music award, for the best classical album. Since then he became one of the most sought recording producers for classical music in Croatia.

TOBIAS STOSIEK
violončelo (Schwerin, Njemačka)
cello (Schwerin, Germany)

Tobias Stosiek rođen je u Šverinu (Schwerin), Njemačka. Violončelo je počeo učiti u Glazbenoj školi Görlitz u klasi Sigurd Richter, a svoje obrazovanje nastavlja u klasi prof. Inge Schreier na Specijalnoj školi za glazbu "Carl Maria von Weber", kao i na Visokoj školi u Drezdenu. Godine 1990. započinje studij u klasi prof. Tobisa Kühnea na Visokoj školi u Beču. Diplomirao je 1998. godine sa najvišom ocjenom, a dodijeljena mu je i specijalna nagrada Saveznog ministarstva za znanost. Bio je stipendista Fonda Albana Berga i DAAD-a. Pohađao je brojne majstorske klase, pored ostalih i kod Petera Leiseganga, Arto Norasa, Davida Geringasa, Fransa Helmersona i Mstislava Rastropovića. Osvorio je I. nagradu na natjecanju "II. Prix-Mercure-Wettbewerb" u Semeringu, 1997. godine, I. nagradu na "IV. International Brahms-Wettbewerb" u Pörtschachu, II. i specijalnu nagradu za najbolje izvođenje Beethovenovog djela na "XXXVI. Beethoven-Wettbewerb" u Hradecu nad Moravicu, II. nagradu na "XXXII. International Instrumentalwettbewerb" u Marknojkirhenu, 2000. godine, I. nagradu na "V. International Violoncelo-Wettbewerb" u Licenu, kao i III. nagradu na XXX. međunarodnom natjecanju "Jeunesses Musicales" u Beogradu. Gostovao je na festivalima i održao brojne koncerte u Njemačkoj, Italiji, Francuskoj, Poljskoj, Češkoj, Srbiji, Hrvatskoj i Austriji (pored ostalog i u Bečkom Koncerthausu i Musikvereinu), kao solista sa orkestrom i često u duetu sa svojom suprugom, pijanisticom Natašom Veljković. Od ožujka 2003. godine Tobias Stosiek radi kao profesor na "Universität für Musik und darstellende Kunst" u Gracu i član je žirija na više međunarodnih takmičenja, kao na primjer na International Brahms-Wettbewerb u Pörtschachu, International Violoncelo-Wettbewerb" u Licenu i "Jeunesses Musicales" u Beogradu.

Tobias Stosiek svira na violončelu Don Nicola Amati (Bologna) iz 1700. godine.

Tobias Stosiek was born in Schwerin (Germany). He received his first cello lessons from Prof. Sigrid Richter at the Görlitz Music School and later with Prof. Inge Schreier at the Special School for Music "Carl Maria von Weber" in Dresden. Between 1990 and 1998 he studied at the "Universität für Musik und darstellende Kunst" in Vienna with Prof. Tobias Kühne. Tobias Stosiek has taken part in several Masterclasses with David Geringas, Frans Helmerson, Peter Leisegang, Arto Noras, Antonio Meneses, Karine Georgian and Mstislav Rostropovich, among others. He has won numerous prizes at International competitions such as the first prize at the 1995 "II. Prix-Mercure Competition" in Semmering (Austria), the first prize at the "IV. International Brahms Competition" in Pörtschach (Austria) in 1997, as well as the first place at the "XXXII. International Instrumental Competition" in Markneukirchen and the first prize at the "V. International Violoncello Competition" in Liezen in 2000 and the first place at the XXX. Int. Competition "Jeunesses Musicales" in Belgrade. He has been a guest artist at many Festivals and has performed throughout Europe. He recorded several CD's and TV-Productions as soloist and chamber music player. Tobias Stosiek is professor on the University of Music and performing Arts Graz. He is member of Jury in several international competitions (Brahms Competition Pörtschach; Violoncello Competition Liezen; "Jeunesses Musicales" in Belgrade. Tobias Stosiek plays on a Don Nicola Amati Cello made in Bologna around 1700.

Violončelist Branimir Pustički (Zagreb, 1981.) diplomirao je iz klase Valtera Dešpalja na Muzičkoj Akademiji u Zagrebu te se usavršavao kod Reinharda Latzka u Beču i Jakoba Kullberga u Stavangeru. Laureat je mnogih domaćih i inozemnih natjecanja i nagrada (Brahms, Lutoslawski, Papandopulo) te solistički nastupa uz mnoge orkestre i ansamble. Za glazbeni arhiv HRT-a snimio je uz Simfonijski orkestar HRT-a djela za violončelo i orkestar hrvatskih skladatelja J. Tkalčića, M. Ruždjaka, M. Kelemenja, K. Seletkovića, G. Tudora i R. Matza, a sa Dubrovačkim simfonijskim orkestrom Koncert za violončelo i gudače P. Dešpalja. Uz dugogodišnju komornu suradnju sa pijanisticom Petrom Gilming i Triom 1887, često nastupa sa istaknutim umjetnicima na koncertima u Hrvatskoj i inozemstvu. Od 2008-2024. solo je violončelist Simfonijskog orkestra HRT-a i Zadarskog komornog orkestra, a od 2019. docent violončela na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu.

Branimir Pustički (Zagreb, 1981) studied with Valter Dešpalj in Zagreb, Reinhard Latzko in Vienna, and with Jakob Kullberg in Stavanger. During his studies, he won prizes in cello competitions in Italy, Poland, Croatia and Austria and was awarded Zagreb Philharmonic/Amex prize for the best young Croatian musician in 2003. Branimir combines a career of a soloist, chamber musician (especially with pianist Petra Gilming and Trio 1887), orchestral musician and a teacher at the Music Academy in Zagreb. From 2008 until 2024 Pustički was the principal cellist of the Croatian Radiotelevision Orchestra. He has also performed as principal cello in many European orchestras. He has given chamber music concerts throughout Europe, in Japan and in the USA. With the the Croatian Radiotelevision Symphony Orchestra he has recorded works for cello and orchestra by Croatian composers Juro Tkalčić, Marko Ruždjak, Milko Kelemen, Gordan Tudor, Krešimir Seletković and Rudolf Matz, and the Cello concerto by Pavle Dešpalj with the Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra.

Ana Granik glazbenu naobrazbu počela je u Glazbenoj školi Vatroslava Lisinskog u Zagrebu u klasi Vere Prokić. Sa dvanaest godina odlazi na Glazbenu akademiju Franz Liszt u Budimpešti u klasu za posebno nadarenu djecu (prof. Zsuzsa Esztó) gdje upisuje i redovan studij u klasi Laszla Baranyija. Usavršavala se na majstor skim tečajevima kod Rudolfa Kehrera i Eugena Indjica. Dobitnica je niza nagrada na međunarodnim natjecanjima. Snimila je više nosača zvuka za mađarski Hun garoton. Odmah po završetku studija dobiva radno mjesto na Konzervatoriju Béla Bartók u Budimpešti, a od 2018. godine stalno je zaposlena kao korepetitor na Akademiji Franz Liszt u Budimpešti. Stalna je korepetitorica na različitim međunarodnim natjecanjima (Antonio Janigro u Hrvatskoj, Bartók International Violin Competition u Mađarskoj) kao i na majstorskim tečajevima (Uzmah/Upbeat).

Ana Granik began her music education at the Vatroslav Lisinski School of Music in Zagreb in the class of Vera Prokić. At the age of 12, she enrolled at the Franz Liszt Academy of Music in Budapest in the class for gifted children (Professor Zsuzsanna Esztó), and later also studied in the class of Laszlo Baranyi. She attended master classes under Rudolf Kehler and Eugen Indjic. She has won a number of awards in international competitions. She recorded several albums for Hungaroton (Hungary). After completing her studies, she obtained a position at the Béla Bartók Conservatory in Budapest, and she has been employed as a répétiteur at the Franz Liszt Academy in Budapest since 2018. Her career as a soloist, chamber musician, and répétiteur of renowned artists has taken her all over the world. She won numerous awards for the best répétiteur in national and international competitions, including the award for the best pianist at the International Tchaikovsky Competition in Russia 2019. David Vuković (Čakovec, 1996.) klavir je počeo učiti u klasi prof. Daniela Maria Novaka u Umjetničkoj školi Miroslav Magdalenić u Čakovcu, a obrazovanje nastavio u klasi prof. Lee Šantek u Glazbenoj školi u Varaždinu. Diplomirao je 2021. na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu u klasi profesora Đorda Stanettija s najvećom pohvalom (summa cum laude), a akademsku godinu 2018./19. proveo je na Musik und Kunst Privatuniversität der Stadt Wien u Beču u klasi prof. Doris Adam kao stipendista Erasmus+ programa. Dobitnik je niza nagrada od kojih se ističu prve nagrade na državnim natjecanjima HDGPP-a u disciplini klavir solo i glasovirska dva, Specijalna nagrada Hrvatskog društva skladatelja za najbolju izvedbu zadane skladbe hrvatskog autora na 9. *EPTA međunarodnom natjecanju za mlade pijaniste* u Osijeku, te dvije prve nagrade na međunarodnom natjecanju *Memorijal Jurica Murai* u Varaždinu. Također, dobitnik je Rektorove nagrade za izvedbu Beethovenovog 4. klavirskog koncerta uz pratnju Zagrebačke filharmonije te je ostvario značajne nastupe uz pratnju Zagrebačkih solista i Varaždinske komornog orkestra. Osim toga, Trio Eusebius je dobitnik Dekanove nagrade za ostvarenja u akademskoj godini 2018./2019., te su ostvarili studijsko snimanje za arhivu HRT-a. Korepeticijom se počeo baviti nakon studija, najprije kao vanjski suradnik na Mužičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu, a od 2022. radi kao nastavnik korepeticije u Glazbenoj školi u Varaždinu.

David Vuković (Čakovec, 1996) started learning piano in the class of prof. Daniel Mario Novak in Art Shool Miroslav Magdalenić Čakovec and continued his education in the class of prof. Lea Šantek in Music School in Varaždin. He graduated in 2021 from Zagreb Academy of Music in the class of prof. Đorđe Stanetti with the highest honor (summa cum laude) and spent the academic year 2018/19 at the Music and Arts Private University of Vienna in the class of prof. Doris Adam as a scholar of the Erasmus+ program. He is a winner of numerous awards, most distinctive being first prizes on the HDGPP national competitions in the disciplines of piano solo and piano duo, Croatian composers society award for the best performance of the compulsory work by a Croatian composer at the 9th *EPTA competition for young pianists* in Osijek and two first prizes at the *Memorijal Jurica Murai* in Varaždin. He has also received the Rector's Award for the performance of Beethoven's 4th Piano Concerto with the Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra, and he performed with the Zagreb Soloists and the Varaždin Chamber Orchestra. During his studies, David intensively started to engage with chamber music, mostly as a member of the Trio Eusebius (along with violinist Eva Šulić Brajčić and cellist Tonka Javorović), with whom he achieved significant success by winning the Papandopulo, Ferdo Livadić and Darko Lukić competitions, as well as notable performances at festival such as Dubrovnik Summer Festival, Osor Musical Evenings, Samobor Music Festival, Croatian Music Festival in Vienna, Evenings on Grič in Zagreb, Musical Evenings at St Donatus in Zadar, the Korkyra Baroque Festival, the Narodni dom Maribor chamber cycle, the Ostinato International Chamber Music Festival Omiš, the "BEETHOVENplus" Festival in Zagreb, the Chamber Music Festival in Čakovec, the Josip Klima Days in Varaždin, the Sfumato cycle of HRT Choir and others. Furthermore, Trio Eusebius won the Dean's Award for achievements in the academic year 2018/2019, and they made a studio recording for the HRT archive. David began working as an accompanist after his studies, first as an external associate at the Zagreb Academy of Music, and since 2022 he has been working as an accompaniment teacher at the Varaždin School of Music.

Ana Labazan Brajša (2002.) studied at the Elly Bašić Music Institute with prof. Luka Magdalenić and graduated in the class of prof. Ines Ana Tomić at the Pavao Markovac Music School. She is a 5th year student in the class of prof. Leonid Sorokow at the Academy of music in Zagreb and she also studies in the class of prof. Anna Kandinskaya at the Joseph Haydn Privathochschule in Eisenstadt (Austria). She is a laureate and winner of many first and special prizes at various international and national competitions. She held concerts in Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Liechtenstein, Austria, Germany, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Spain, Bulgaria, India and China. Ana is intensively engaged in chamber music, as well as performing and researching music from the Baroque period to the present day. In the year 2018.
